HAPPY NEW YEAR

As we begin a new year and new decade I have some good news and reasons for to be grateful.

The first *Good News* is that our Christmas celebrations were well attended, the decorations were superb, the music was heavenly and there was no snow! The 2nd *Good News* is that our collection was \$4,860.00 – a little better than last year!

The really *Good News* is our Stewardship of Treasure report! 194 households made a Stewardship of treasure pledge (167 last year) Total dollars pledged were \$280,333.00 (\$235,223.00 last year).

St. John Vianney's pledges increased from 11 to 15.

Total dollars pledged rose from \$12,870.00 to \$16,729.00.

I want to thank everyone who has committed to do their part to meet our financial responsibilities in our communities. We do this because *WE BELONG!*

There's more *Good News* too! The year ahead promises to be busy, action-packed and Spirit and fun-filled. I hope we will continue to develop and live out our goal of continuing and creating new ways to show that *WE BELONG* to the Body of Christ and to one another, inside and outside our spiritual communities.

Another big effort this year will be welcoming back those who respond to the "*Catholics Come Home*" television initiative of the Archdiocese. Beginning with the first week of Lent through Easter there will be television adds encouraging those who have been away from us for awhile to return. What a wonderful opportunity we will have to show them that indeed they do *BELONG!* Very often people begin by asking us to share our Catholic faith. What an opportunity to evangelize and to welcome people back.

At St. John Vianney we will create new traditions as we make fuller use of Campbell Hall. Already we have established our annual Christmas party and spiritual gathering are in the works. I'm sure we'll have a few parties too!
